Strawberry Picking, Wine Tasting & Fortress

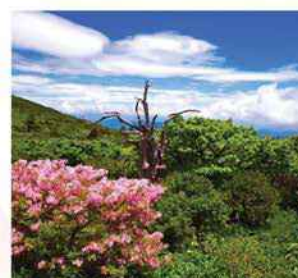
Gochangupseong Fortress & Dolmen Site

Sun, 24 Mar, 0900-1700

(1-hr bus ride)

The Gochang Moyang Fortress was built in 1453 to prevent Japanese invasions and has a 1.6km-long wall surrounding a bamboo forest, numerous trees and scattered buildings. At the Dolmen Museum, you can view diverse relics and learn about the Bronze Age and the dolmen (tomb, gravesite, etc) cultures of the world.



Deogyusan National Park

Sat, 6 Apr, 0730-1830
